



Address markers are a crucial element to safe and proper wildfire mitigation practices. Address markers should be clearly visible from both directions on the road. This makes it much easier for fire crews to quickly identify a house in cases of an emergency.

Signs should be mounted on noncombustible metal t-posts. Use white reflective letters mounted on a green background. Some Fire Protection Districts prefer a different background color. If multiple homes are on one drive, use multiple signs to clearly indicate where your home is located.
